



Dorset Council Infrastructure Funding Statement

Reporting Year: 2019/20

The Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) regulations require all local planning authorities that issue a CIL liability notice or enter into section 106 planning obligations during a reporting year to publish an infrastructure funding statement (IFS) at least annually. The infrastructure funding statement should, as a minimum, include the information set out in [Schedule 2 to the Community Infrastructure Levy regulations 2010](#) (as inserted by the 2019 regulations).

This infrastructure funding statement gives policy makers and communities better insight into how developer contributions are supporting new development and local infrastructure.

Dorset Council is the charging authority for four adopted CIL charging schedules that have been implemented as follows:

- East Dorset Area – 3rd January 2017;
- Purbeck Area – 5th June 2014;
- West Dorset – 18th July 2016;
- Weymouth & Portland – 18th July 2016;

This statement provides information for Dorset Council for the financial year April 2019 to March 2020. The report is split into two parts. Part A covers Community Infrastructure Levy. Part B covers planning obligations, commonly referred to as s106 agreements.
