

# If BCP had 100 children and young people

**52**

would be boys

**48**

would be girls

**85**

would be White British

**5**

would be living in areas that are in the most deprived national decile (based on IMD 2019)

**9**

would be living in areas that are in the least deprived national decile (based on IMD 2019)

**1**

would receive targeted early help from Families First

**52**

would be breastfed at 6-8 weeks

**95**

would be vaccinated against DTaP-IPV-Hib\* at the age of 2

**91**

would be immunised against MMR\* at the age of 5

**16**

would have a SEN\* or EHCP\* (at primary school age)

**8**

would be classified as obese at 4-5 years old

**18**

would be classified as obese at 10-11 years old

**74**

would achieve a good level of development by the end of Reception Year

**48**

school age children would be physically active

**15**

would be physically active for at least 1 hour per day 7 days per week, at age 15

**8**

would be persistently absent from Primary school education

**13**

would be persistently absent from Secondary school education

**3**

school age children would have social, emotional and mental health needs, however the majority would have good emotional wellbeing

**5**

would not be in education, employment or training at the age of 16-17

\*DTaP-IPV-Hib = This is the 5-in1 combination vaccine protecting against diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (whooping cough), polio and Haemophilus influenzae type B.

\*MMR: Measles, Mumps and Rubella
