3. Is the site remote and/or can it be seen from other highways or rights of way?

Southern ends of both the current bridleway and the current footpath and the proposed new bridleway terminate near Chantry Farmhouse and other dwellings. Northern parts of current bridleway and the proposed new bridleway are more remote and cannot be seen from other highways or rights of way.

4. Does the site have a good mobile phone signal or is there easy access to a public telephone should the emergency services be required?

O2, Vodafone and EE signals. No public telephone.

5. Is the right of way easily accessible? Will arrangements for access by the Inspector need to be made in advance?

Current bridleway C – F is not passable due to surface conditions, vegetation and barbed wire. It can be viewed from points C, D and F. The current footpath A – Q can be walked between A and the point that it crosses the proposed new bridleway between P and O. On the day it was inspected the section from the point that it crosses the proposed new bridleway between P and O and point Q was overgrown and could not be walked but it can be viewed from P – O – Q. The proposed new bridleway can be walked.
