

**THE DORSET COUNCIL (WASHPOND LANE, SWANAGE) (SCHOOL STREET)  
(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) (EXPERIMENTAL ORDER) 2026**

Notice is hereby given that the Council of Dorset has made the above-mentioned Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. Relevant exemptions will apply where appropriate and as necessary in accordance with the provisions of the Order.

When the Experimental Order comes into operation on the 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2026 the effect will be to prohibit the driving of motor vehicles on a section of Washpond Lane, Swanage during the hours of 8.20am until 8.30am and 3.25pm until 3.35pm on every school day.

The reason for proceeding by way of experimental order is to assess the effects of the changes before Dorset Council considers whether the provisions of the Experimental Traffic Regulation Order shall continue in force indefinitely.
