Dorset Council (Footpath 51, Dorchester and Footpath 6, Winterborne Monkton)

Public Path Diversion Order 2020

This Order is made by Dorset Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the lines of the paths should be diverted.

interests of the public and in the

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the County of Dorset definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

The Duchy of Cornwall has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new sites of the paths into a fit condition for use by the public.

Dorchester Town Council, Winterborne Farringdon Grouped Parish Council and Winterborne St Martin Parish Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- The public rights of way over the land situate at Dorchester and Winterborne Monkton and shown by bold continuous lines on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order or on the date which Dorset Council certify that work has been carried out to bring the sites of the new highways mentioned in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order into a fit condition for use by the public, whichever is the later and thereupon the County of Dorset definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it those public rights of way.
- 2. Notwithstanding this Order, where immediately before the date on which the paths are diverted in pursuance of this Order, there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across the paths belonging to the statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying out their undertaking then such undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of their apparatus as they would have had if this Order had never been made.
- 3. There shall at the end of 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be public footpaths over the land situate at Dorchester and Winterborne Monkton described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by bold broken lines on the map contained in this Order and thereupon the County of Dorset definitive map shall be modified by adding those paths to it.

- 4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.
- 5. The County of Dorset definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.

Footpath 51, Dorchester:

A – B From Ladock Terrace at point A (SY 67159019), south west across Middle Farm Way (B3150) to a grass bank and then west and north west to the A35 Dorchester bypass at its junction with Footpath 6, Winterborne Monkton at the Winterborne Monkton parish boundary at point B (SY 67029020). Width: The width of Footpath 51 is 1.8 metres.

Footpath 6, Winterborne Monkton:

B – B1 – The full width of the Footpath from the Dorchester town boundary, on the A35 C Dorchester bypass at its junction with Footpath 51, Dorchester at point B (SY 67029020), west north west across the A35 to point B1 (SY 66999020) and continuing generally south west across a field to its junction with Martinstown Road (C53) at point C (SY 66479003).

Width: 2 metres.
