HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 118B SPECIAL EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER FOR CERTAIN HIGHWAYS WHICH CROSS LAND OCCUPIED FOR THE PURPOSES OF A SCHOOL AND WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER

Dorset Council (Part of Footpath 131, Weymouth) Public Path Special Extinguishment Order 2024

This Order is made by Dorset Council ("the Council") under section 118B (4) of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the council that as respects the relevant highway described in Article 1 below ("the highway") -

- (a) the Council is the highway authority for area;
- (b) the highway crosses land occupied for the purposes of a school; and
- (c) it is expedient for the purposes of protecting the pupils or staff from
 - i. violence or the threat of violence.
 - ii. harassment.
 - alarm or distress arising from unlawful activity, iii.
 - any other risk to their health or safety arising from such activity, iv.

that the highway should be stopped up.

The police authority, Dorset Police, for the area in which the highway lies have been consulted as required by section 118B(6) of the 1980 Act.

Weymouth Town Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2)(a) of the 1980 Act.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the County of Dorset definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the stopping up (as authorised by this Order) of a highway hitherto shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

BY THIS ORDER:

- The public right of way over the land situate at Radipole Primary School, 1. Weymouth parish and shown by a continuous bold line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be extinguished after 7 days from the date of confirmation of this order and thereupon the County of Dorset definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way and the definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this order.
- 2. Notwithstanding this Order, where immediately before the date on which the path is extinguished in pursuance of this order, there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across the path belonging to the statutory undertakers for

the purpose of carrying out their undertaking then such undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of their apparatus as they would have had if this Order had never been made.
