I write with reference to my letter dated 27th December 2025. Further information has come to light around the liability for maintenance of the bridleway which has changed our opinion and we no longer wish to support the application to extinguish the bridleway. We do support maintenance of the route which avoids users walking and riding through the farmyard at Chantry Farm - the permissive path route past The Granary to the left and up through the field is a safer route to link to the bridleway and path through the woods.
