A – B is not available on the ground. The nearest usable routes are muddy and waterlogged in some areas, so walking boots / wellies are recommended/

2. Is there any likelihood of exposure to pets or other animals which may present a risk to the safety of the Inspector?

None encountered at the time of the site visit.

3. Is the site remote and/or can it be seen from other highways or rights of way?

Yes, it is remote. The footpath can be seen from Footpath 18. Point B connects with the C38 road.

4. Does the site have a good mobile phone signal or is there easy access to a public telephone should the emergency services be required?

Yes, good mobile phone signal and 4g. No public telephone.

5. Is the right of way easily accessible? Will arrangements for access by the Inspector need to be made in advance?

The footpath cannot be walked. It is possible to park on the side of the road at point B and view the route. It is also possible to park at the junction of Witcham Lane / Broom Hill and walk along Witcham Lane – Footpath 15, Footpath 18, and then a permissive footpath to the east of Footpath 18. The footpath can be viewed from a gate to the north east of point A.

6. Are there any dangerous pieces of equipment or substances stored at any point along the right of way?

No

7. If there is any other relevant information which the Inspector should be aware of that is not covered in this questionnaire?

Footpaths 17 and 18 are offline. A walked route is available from Witcham Lane, along part of Footpath 18 then continuing along a permissive route to the east of Footpath 18. This enables views of the route A – B from a gate.
